WP4: objectives


- Main objectives:

 "science with the VO"




WP4 activities have a large overlap with those of the EURO-VO Facility Centre

WP4 activities: Science Advisory Committee (SAC) meetings

WP4 activities: Research Initiative

- D4.3 (month 17): Second Announcement of Opportunity
 - ✓ Call released on May 20, with a deadline of July 15; 11 applications received (http://www.euro-vo.org/pub/fc/AIDA call 2009.html)
 - ✓ Aim: scientific and technical support to teams interested in carrying out astronomical projects utilising VO tools
 - ✓ The proposals have been evaluated by the SAC on their scientific merits; AIDA scientists and technical experts are assessing their feasibility
 - ✓ A face-to-face meeting with the top-ranked teams will be held to assess the needs of the projects; support likely to start soon after



WP4 activities: VO "Hands-on" School

- ESO, March 30 April 2 (3 full days)
- Web page: http://www.euro-vo.org/aidahandson2009/
- Goal:
 - expose (young) European astronomers to VO tools and services so that they can use them efficiently for their own research
- Methods:
 - lecture and tutor the participants on the usage of such tools
 - give real life examples of scientific applications (some selected from those submitted by participants)
 - hands-on exercises
- Participants:
 - -40 students (out of ~ 75 applicants)
